Stewardship Bulletin Bit

"They all ate and were satisfied. And when the leftover fragments were picked up, they filled twelve wicker baskets."

—Luke 9:17

The story of the Loaves and Fishes shows us that when you share what you have, even if it doesn't seem like that much, miracles can happen! Do not think that your gift is too small or insignificant! Each of us has a role in God's plan; you just need to place your trust in the Lord. Nothing is impossible with God. You may be the answer to someone else's prayer.

UNDERSTANDING THE VARIOUS KINDS OF MASS



We have many feast days alongside our Sunday Masses this time of year, but Sundays and Solemnities are not the only "kinds" of Mass.

There are also **Ritual Masses**, such as for weddings, confirmations, and certain other sacraments and events. On weekdays, there are **Ferial Masses**—"feria" is the Church's term for weekdays without feasts. Since antiquity, the ferias of Lent and of the last 8 days of Advent have

been of special importance. There are also Vigil Masses, an anticipatory extension of a solemnity; from the tradition of keeping watches ("vigilia") of prayer at night, preparing for the feast's arrival. Funerals and



Masses for the Departed are another, our exsequial rites for mourning, prayer for the dead, and hope in Christ.

Sometimes, replacing the usual ferial (weekday) Mass, the priest prays a Votive Mass or a Mass for Various Needs or Occasions. Votive Masses are to honour a particular mystery of the Lord's life, or a saint. Popular ones include Saturdays for Our Lady, 1st Fridays to the Sacred Heart, and 1st Thursdays to Jesus' Eternal High Priesthood; but there are others. The Masses for Various Needs include prayers just as the name says: for various needs—for rain, fine weather, the sick, the dying, more vocations to religious life, for thanksgiving, reconciliation—and forty more!

May heavenly choirs of angels welcome Betty and Marita into their eternal home, and may God's grace bring comfort and strength to their loved ones during this time of sorrow.




MIRACLE QUILTERS UPDATE
