—Ezekiel 2:2-3

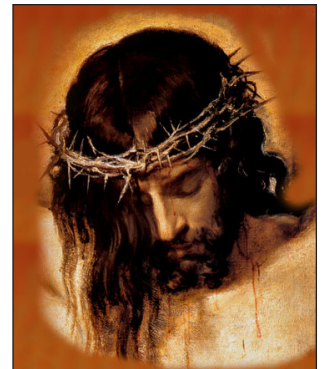

JULY—DEVOTED to the PRECIOUS BLOOD of JESUS



Devotion to the Precious Blood has deep historical roots in the Church, dating back to the early centuries of Christianity.

This devotion gained prominence over time, leading to the establishment of the Feast of the Most Precious Blood (formerly on the 1st Sunday of July). Designating July as the month dedicated to the Precious Blood provides believers with a specific period to deepen our devotion to Jesus' sacrifice—with special prayers and liturgies focused on the Precious Blood.



This devotion is centered on honoring and meditating upon the Blood that Jesus Christ shed during His Crucifixion for the redemption of humanity—emphasizing the profound spiritual significance of Jesus' sacrifice and the salvific power of His Blood.

Through the shedding of His Blood, Jesus offered Himself as a perfect sacrifice to reconcile humanity with God and to atone for sin—the ultimate expression of God's love and mercy, as it was freely given.

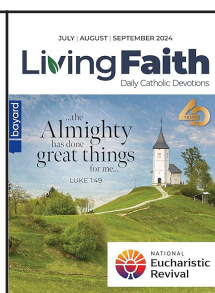
We believe that the Eucharist is the true Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, nourishing us spiritually and uniting us more closely to Christ.

CAMP SEASON CANCELLED for 2024

The start of this season was one full of excitement, increased support of amazing on-site volunteers, and many prayer warriors as we prepared to welcome campers this 2024 season. So it is with mixed emotions that we inform our camp family and faithful supporters that as of July 1, 2024, we do not have the minimum number of registrations needed (10 campers) for any of our camps offered. So camps will not be offered this season. All paid registrations will be fully refunded.



Chris Ruest will remain as our summer director for the season, living onsite at camp as he continues to fundraise and connect with campers/supporters in the Swift Current, Moose-Jaw/Gravelbourg, and Eaton Deaneries.

As we pivot in a new direction, this will include hosting an Achdiocese of Regina Young Adults service weekend, putting together new rental packages, welcoming those that would like to adopt a cabin/project, working towards remediation of the north washrooms, hosting a wedding rental, and investing in team leadership for next season.
