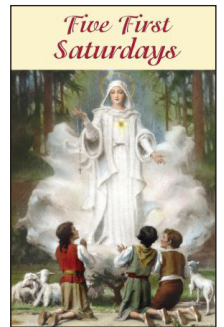
THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY



The month of August is dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

The physical heart of Mary is venerated (not adored as the Sacred Heart of Jesus is) because it is united to her person and is the seat of her love, virtue, and inner life. Such devotion is an incentive to a similar love and virtue. This devotion has received new emphasis in this century from the visions given in 1925 and 1926 to Lucy Dos Santos, oldest of the visionaries of Fatima.

In the visions Our Lady asked for the practice of the **Five First Saturdays** to help make amends for the offences committed against her heart by the blasphemies and ingratitude of men. The practice parallels the devotion of the Nine First Fridays in honor of the Sacred Heart. Let us remember this devotion year-round, but particularly through the month of August.



Daily Offering to the Immaculate Heart of Mary

O Jesus, through the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I offer you my prayers, works, joys and suffering of this day in union with the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass throughout the world. I offer them for all the intentions of Your Sacred Heart: the salvation of souls, reparation for sins, and the reunion of all Christians. I offer them for the intentions of our Bishops and of all Apostles of Prayer—in particular for those recommended by our Holy Father this month.
