BECOMING ROMAN CATHOLIC



If you (or someone you know) would like to hear more about Jesus, we invite you to join us at an Inquiry Session.

This does not assume a commitment to join the Catholic faith family, but is a first step—where you inquire, explore and search for ways to grow in your relationship with God. We invite those who have not been baptized into any faith denomination, those who have been baptized into a non-Catholic faith denomination, or baptized Catholics contemplating also receiving the sacraments of Eucharist or Confirmation.

Inquirers attend Inquiry sessions until they make a decision to join the Catholic faith family. They are then invited to

enter the process called the **Rite of Initiation of Adults** (RCIA), which leads to

the reception of the



Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism (for those who have not been baptized), Confirmation, and Eucharist.

Some people will need more time than others as they prepare for the lifetime commitment that comes with membership in the Catholic Church. The usual length of preparation time is 1-2 years. However, this time commitment may be shorter for those who have already been baptized and are seeking full communion in the Catholic Church (receiving Confirmation and Eucharist).
