Stewardship Bulletin Bit

"Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him."

—John 6:56

This line from Scripture is what ultimately separates Catholics from our Protestant brothers and sisters. Jesus is really present in the bread and wine that are consecrated at Holy Mass. It is His actual body and blood that we consume. The Eucharist is the greatest gift we can receive, and shows the great love that Jesus has for each of us.

BECOMING ROMAN CATHOLIC



If you (or someone you know) would like to hear more about Jesus, we invite you to join us at an Inquiry Session.

This does not assume a commitment to join the Catholic faith family, but is a first step—where you inquire, explore and search for ways to grow in your relationship with God. We invite those who have not been baptized into any faith denomination, those who have been baptized into a non-Catholic faith denomination, or baptized Catholics contemplating also receiving the sacraments of Eucharist or Confirmation.

Inquirers attend Inquiry sessions until they make a decision to join the Catholic faith family. They are then invited to enter the process called the **Rite of Initiation of Adults** (RCIA), which leads to the reception of the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism (for those who have not been baptized), Confirmation, and Eucharist.

Some people will need more time than others as they prepare for the lifetime commitment that comes with membership in the Catholic Church. The usual length of preparation time is 1-2 years. However, this time commitment may be shorter for those who have already been baptized and are seeking full communion in the Catholic Church (receiving Confirmation and Eucharist).

If you wish your child to be baptized in September, October or November, you must attend the mandatory Baptism preparation class on **Wed, August 28 at 7 pm** in the library. Forms are available from the office, and should be returned to Eileen Hartman or Fr Ferdinand in advance.

Guest Leah Perrault spoke on our guiding principle for the next two years: "Here I am Lord, send me." Her message was powerful and inspiring.

Breakout sessions informed us on many topics—from palliative care, leadership and social media, to catechesis and women in the church. Resolutions were passed on a variety of mental health/social justice issues.

Lots of great food and fun was had as we dressed as pirates, dancing to Brad Johner & Sons; and enjoyed "A Taste of Ukraine," singing along with the talented and hilarious Ukeladies. Executive reports and a lively Q&A session rounded out the convention, enjoyed by all.
