A disciple is a person who spends time in prayer every day, joyfully participates in charitable works, and generously supports their local parish and Church mission. If we say we serve God, our words and actions should reflect the Gospel message to others.

MEMORIAL of SAINT MONICA: August 27th



Monica is the Patron Saint of homemakers, married women, mothers, abuse victims, alcoholics and widows. She is invoked against

difficult marriages and difficult children.

Raised in a Christian home, Monica became quite devout, overcoming an early addiction to alcohol. She was given in marriage to Patricius, a pagan, said to have had a violent temper and an immoral lifestyle. He opposed her

Christian faith but also saw in her something worthy of respect. Together, they had three children, among them one of the Church's greatest saints: Saint Augustine.

Monica prayed fervently for her family's conversion. Patricius was converted and baptized around 370, one year before he died. Patricius' mother also converted.



Augustine, who had always searched for truth, was finally drawn to the Bishop of Milan and future Saint Ambrose. Augustine converted to Christianity at age 33, and was baptized in 387. Augustine went on to become one of the most influential theologians in Church history.

Saint Monica, you continually turned your difficulties over to God. You prayed, grew in virtue, and had a profound impact on your whole family. Please pray that I will never lose hope for those who have gone astray but will remain faithful in prayer for them, trusting in God's divine mercy. Amen.
