St Michael ("Who is like God?")

St Gabriel ("Strength of God")

St Raphael ("God heals")

St Michael is the patron of courage, protection and divine

intervention. Anyone can ask for St Michael's protection, but he particularly defends against evil. Pope Leo XIII (1878-1903) had a vision of the evil that would come into the world in the coming century. In response, he wrote the St Michael's Prayer and instructed it to be prayed at the end of Mass.



St Gabriel is the patron of messengers. Zechariah and his wife Elizabeth had been unable to have children, and Elizabeth was well beyond childbearing years. St Gabriel approached Zechariah:

"Do not be afraid, Zechariah, for your prayer is heard, and your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you shall call his name John." (Luke 1:13)

St Raphael is the patron of healings and ordained marriage. He travelled with a man named Tobias and helped him by releasing his future wife, Sarah, from spiritual bondage and healing Tobias' father who was blind.

*Help us, O Lord, to realize more fully the reality of archangels and their desire to serve us.
Holy angels, pray for us. Amen.*

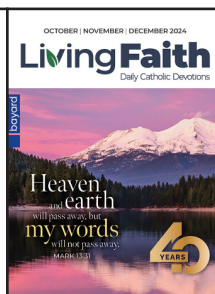
HELP CREATE SLIDES for WEEKEND MASSES

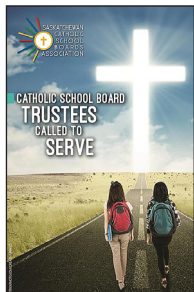

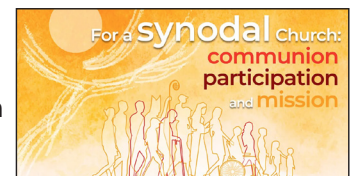
