OUR LADY of the ROSARY - October 7



The Church celebrates the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary on October 7, in recognition of the Holy League's defeat of the Ottoman Empire in the Battle of Lepanto on October 7, 1571.

In the late 16th century, Christian Europe was weak and splintered. Politically, Europe was just a collection of small, warring kingdoms. The Ottoman Empire, on the other hand, was strong and growing, having not lost a significant naval battle in a hundred years. Its forces had already conquered the remains of the eastern half of the Roman Empire.



Knowing the desperate circumstances, Pope Saint Pius V did the only thing those back at home could do: pray. On the day of the battle, he organized a public procession in Rome to pray the Rosary. Even though

the Turkish forces were very powerful, the Christians won due to the intercession of Mary and the prayer of the Most Holy Rosary.

As an offering of thanksgiving, the Pope declared this day as the feast day of Our Lady of Victory, later known as Our Lady of the Rosary.
