Stewardship Bulletin Bit

"My kingdom does not belong to this world."

—John 18:36

Life is short. How much time, energy and money do you put into building "your" kingdom here on earth? We all know we can't take it with us. The real kingdom is in the next life. Yet, how much time, energy and money do you invest in working for that eternal kingdom? Ask God for guidance, detach from earthly possessions, and generously share with others for the greater glory of God.

PREPARING FOR A "HAPPY DEATH"



"If angels were capable of envy, they would envy us for two things: one is the receiving of Holy Communion, and the other is suffering." —St Faustina

Jesus is the Bread of Life. It is important for the sick and the dying to receive the Eucharist indefinitely.

When someone is declining or nearing death, ensure that a priest gives them the sacrament of the **Anointing of the Sick** (even if they are unconscious) so their sins are absolved—and the Sacrament of Reconciliation as needed.



Have the dying, including infants, baptized with water. Mother Teresa proclaimed that her Sisters asked everyone who died at her home for the dying, "Would you like a blessing that will forgive your sins and bring you to see God?" Everyone agreed and the Sisters [or clergy if available] baptized all of the dying.

Laity can baptize in an emergency situation by pouring pure water over the dying person's head and saying the words: "I baptize you in the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit."


