# Stewardship Bulletin Bit

"But rather, love your enemies and do good to them, and lend without expecting."

—Luke 6:35

Easier said than done, right? But, if we are to imitate Christ, most of us need to practice mercy and compassion more frequently. Start with the little daily annoyances that we experience, the unkind word or hateful glance we receive. Instead of plotting revenge on that person, try saying a quick prayer for them. Praying for our enemies doesn't change them; it changes us. Mercy and compassion will keep us on the path to holiness.

#### THE NICENE CREED: I Believe in the Holy Spirit



From Catechism of the Catholic Church, 683:

"No one can say 'Jesus is Lord' except by the Holy Spirit."

"God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, 'Abba! Father!'"

This knowledge of faith is possible only in the Holy Spirit: to be in touch with Christ, we must first have been touched by the Holy Spirit. He comes to meet us and kindles faith in us. By virtue of our Baptism, the



first sacrament of the faith, the Holy Spirit in the Church communicates to us, intimately and personally, the life that originates in the Father and is offered to us in the Son.

Baptism gives us the grace of new birth in God the Father, through his Son, in the Holy Spirit. For those who bear God's Spirit are led to the Word, that is, to the Son, and the Son presents them to the Father, and the Father confers incorruptibility on them and it is impossible to see God's Son without the Spirit, and no one can approach the Father without the Son, for the knowledge of the Father is the Son, and the knowledge of God's Son is obtained through the Holy Spirit.

#### **REMINDER on FASTING and ABSTINENCE**



Did you know? All Fridays of the year are days of abstinence from meat, but Catholics may substitute special acts of charity or piety on this day. However, during Lent, penance is an

important requirement of Christian life. Fulfillment of this duty involves prayer, works of piety and charity, and self-denial by fulfilling one's obligations more faithfully—and especially by observing the prescribed fast and abstinence.

wAsh Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays are days of abstinence (no meat) for all Catholics aged 14 or older. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, those between the ages of 18 and 59, must also fast (limit the amount of food) on those days.
