

## **Christ the Redeemer Growing Project 2020**

The Lentil harvest for our Growing Project has been completed. SkyHawk Ent (Dunnington's) sprayed the field to assist with its dry down on August 18<sup>th</sup>. Then on Sept 1<sup>st</sup> the harvest was able to happen. Pattison Ag (JD Dealer) brought over a tractor and a combine to straight cutting the fields. Curtis Argue supplied the Grain Cart, while Marlow Gilbertson and Gary Moen supplied the trucks to get the lentils to market. B&A Petroleum brought out and donated fuel for the Combine and Tractor. Even Pastors Anthony and Thomas stopped by to check out the harvest.

The Red lentils were sold to Viterra here in Swift Current. The proceeds were divided up with a portion going to the Canadian Food Grains (Under a Development and Peace Project). The remaining funds after expenses go our Building Fund to help pay down the principal on the mortgage.

Unfortunately, with Covid, there won't be a wrap up supper this fall. However, we would like to thank all who helped out with the project in so many ways. This includes the Farms and Corporate sponsors and all those who gave seed money as Fundraising Farmers.

With just enough rains to get a 24 bushel per acre yield, the project was a success. The Net Profit should be known in a couple weeks as more expenses still need to be paid.
